

Scripture Reading and Prayer Guide for October/November 2017

This prayer guide is designed to lead us in unified prayer for our families, our church, our community, and our nation. The daily passages are related to forthcoming Sunday morning messages.

Week Two:

October 8 – Philippians 1. Pray for God's anointing upon the Sunday School teachers, the small group leaders, our worship team, and our worship service!

October 9 – John 1. Praise God for His Word!

October 10 – John 2. Pray that God would give His people a heart for prayer.

October 11 – John 3. Thank God for His love for us!

October 12 – John 4. Ask God who He would have you talk to about the true needs of life.

October 13 – John 5. Pray that we would gladly and eagerly receive the truth of God.

October 14 – John 6:1-40. Pray that our eyes will not be on the works of God, but on God, Himself...

Week Three:

October 15 – John 6:41-71. Pray that the Holy Spirit would prepare the hearts of the people today so that we can receive even the hard truths of God.

October 16 – John 7. Thank God for the fulfilled promise of the Holy Spirit.

October 17 - John 8. Pray that the Light of Life will invade every aspect of our lives.

October 18 – John 9. Pray that God would open the eyes of the spiritually blind.

October 19 – John 10. Ask God to lead, guide, and unify our Pastor Search Team as they seek to find the pastor the Lord would have at Greenwell Springs.

October 20 – John 11. Praise God! Jesus IS the Resurrection and the Life!

October 21 – John 12. Pray for boldness to stand as living testimonies of God's power and love.

Week Four:

October 22 – Philippians 2. Pray for God's anointing upon the Sunday School teachers, the small group leaders, our worship team members, and our ministers to use them for His purposes.

October 23 – John 13. Pray that God would create in us hearts of servants like Jesus.

October 24 – John 14. Ask God to help us proclaim that Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life!

October 25 – John 15. Pray that you would always abide in Christ, the True Vine.

October 26 – John 16. Ask God to keep our hearts from being troubled in the midst of tribulation.

October 27 – John 17. Thank God for Jesus our Intercessor. Jesus prayed for you – agree with Him!

October 28 – John 18. Ask God to give us the courage to stand in our day of testing.

Week Five:

October 29 – Philippians 3. Pray for God's anointing upon the Sunday School teachers, the small group leaders, our worship team members, and our ministers to use them for His purposes.

October 30 – John 19. Thank God that the work of redemption was FINISHED on the cross!

October 31 – John 20-21. Thank God that the tomb is EMPTY!

November 1 – Proverbs 1. Ask God to lead you into the wisdom and knowledge of His word.

November 2 – Proverbs 2. Pray that God would give you a greater understanding of His word.

November 3 – Proverbs 3. Trust God and allow Him to direct your path.

November 4 – Proverbs 4. Ask God to help you keep your heart, mind, and soul focused upon Him.

Week One:

November 5 – Proverbs 5. Ask God to speak through the Holy Spirit to us in our Sunday School and worship time together today.

November 6 – Proverbs 6. Thank God that His truth can guide us and protect us in a morally corrupt world.

November 7 – Proverbs 7. Ask God to keep you from the ways of destruction.

November 8 – Proverbs 8. Ask God to give us wisdom as we seek His will as a church body.

November 9 – Proverbs 9. Pray that God would give us hearts that are open to correction.

November 10 – Proverbs 10. Ask God to help you hold fast to His instruction.

November 11 – Proverbs 11. Thank God for those who have been willing to lay down their lives for the freedoms we enjoy as Americans.

Week Two:

November 12 – Proverbs 12. Pray that our lives would be changed as we worship God and study His word.

November 13 – Proverbs 13. Ask God to put a guard at your mouth – Prov. 13:3

November 14 – Proverbs 14. Thank God for the oxen in your life.

November 15 – Proverbs 15. Thank God that He hears the prayers of those who are made righteous in Jesus.

November 16 – Proverbs 16. Ask God to help you commit EVERYTHING to Him.

November 17 – Proverbs 17. Pray and ask God to establish a calmness within your spirit.

November 18 – Proverbs 18. Thank God that "The name of the Lord is a strong tower..."
