

**Scripture Reading and Prayer Guide for
December 2017 & January 2018**

This prayer guide is designed to lead us in unified prayer for our families, our church, our community, and our nation.

December 1 – Psalm 1-3. Pray that your heart would delight in the word of God and that you would daily meditate upon it.

December 2 – Psalm 4-6. Pray that the Lord would lead you in His righteousness and make your way straight.

December 3 – Psalm 7-8 . Praise the Lord today according to His righteousness!

December 4 – Psalm 9-11. No matter what you may be facing in life, declare your trust in the Lord!

December 5 – Psalm 12-15. Pray that our nation would be led by godly men and women who fear the Lord.

December 11 – Psalm 27-30. Ask God to help you wait upon Him!

December 12 – Psalm 31-33. Pray that America would return to God and that it would begin with each of us!

December 13 – Psalm 34-35. Bless the Lord! Praise His name! Magnify His name!

December 14 – Psalm 36-37. Thank the Lord for His faithfulness to those who call upon and believe in Him!

December 15 – Psalm 38-40. Ask God to give you the opportunity and courage to tell your story of God's love.

December 16 – Psalm 41-43. Pray for a consuming desire for the presence of the Lord.

December 17 - Psalm 44-45. Pray that our church would be such that God's favor can and will be upon it!

December 18 – Psalm 46-49. Pray that in the midst of global instability, the nations will see that God reigns!

December 19 – Psalm 50-52. Like the Psalmist, do you need God to create a clean heart in you?
